



COVID-19 DECISION TREE – EMPLOYEES

- Possible COVID-19 Symptoms**
- Fever (Over 100.3°F)
 - Loss of smell or taste
 - Cough
 - Muscle aches
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills
 - New or unusual headache
 - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or loss of appetite

YES SYMPTOMS



- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Notify Dept. Manager and HR and **stay home** or if at work, **go home**
 2. Contact physician and follow medical care and advice
 3. Coordinate with HR to obtain COVID-19 Test per DPB protocol
- HUMAN RESOURCES WILL**
1. Coordinate with employee to obtain COVID-19 Test per DPB protocol
 2. Work with employee to determine contact tracing

NO SYMPTOMS



Is Employee aware of someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for COVID-19 with whom they may have been in contact



- Yes, there was direct physical or close contact (less than 6 feet) for 10 minutes or more where neither party was using face masks or coverings**
- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Notify Department Manager and HR and **coordinate with HR to obtain a COVID-19 Test** per DPB protocol
 2. **Stay home** and monitor by checking for fever and symptoms
 3. Follow directives for “If Employee Tests Positive” or “If Employee Tests Negative”
- HUMAN RESOURCES WILL**
1. Coordinate with employee to obtain COVID-19 Test per DPB protocol
 2. Work with employee to determine contact tracing

- Yes, there was non-close contact (greater than 6 feet) and/or the contact lasted less than 10 minutes**
- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Self-monitor by checking for fever and symptoms.
 2. Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene
 3. Follow directives for “YES SYMPTOMS” if symptoms appear
- HUMAN RESOURCES WILL**
1. No specific action is needed

- No, the employee is unaware of any contact with someone who is known to be infected or diagnosed with COVID-19**
- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene
- HUMAN RESOURCES WILL**
1. No specific action is needed

If Employee Tests **Positive**

- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Notify Human Resources of the result
 2. Continue medical care as instructed
 3. Return to work **only** after: **72 hours** have passed since **complete recovery** (No fever and improvement of respiratory symptoms) **AND** 12 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
- OR**
- 2 negative COVID-19 Tests** done at least 24 hours apart (copy of results to HR)

If Employee Tests **Negative**

- EMPLOYEE WILL**
1. Notify HR of result (printed copy of results to HR)
 2. Continue medical care as instructed
 3. Return to work **after 48 hours** have passed since recovery (No fever and general improvement of symptoms) **AND** negative test results
